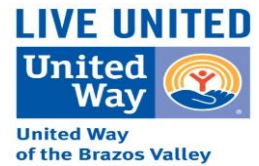


United Way of the Brazos Valley

All interns must be present for the Orientation. The date of orientation will be scheduled during the first week of the internship period.

- **Notification:** Selected applicants will be notified by May 13, 2019.

Internship Period: May 20 – August 9, 2019. All interns must be present for the Orientation and professional development event.
